Useful Information

1. Registration

The registration desk is open 1pm-2pm on Wednesday 16 September, 8am-10.30am and 12-2pm on Thursday 17 September, 8am-10.30am and 12-2pm on Friday 18 September. At other times please contact a member of the organising team (with green badges) for help.

2. Internet access

You will find a ticket for Lapwing connection in your conference pack. To connect to WiFi, find 'Lapwing' on the list of WiFi connections on your device and key in the username and password from your ticket. But if you have installed Eduroam on your device, you should be connected to Eduroam automatically, without using the ticket.

3. Lunch

There are two nearby butteries to grab a quick lunch.

The Buttery at Newnham College is downstairs from Lucia Windsor Room, next to the registration desk. You can pay by cash for a sandwich or a hot lunch. There is also a selection of snacks and drinks.

The Sidgwick Site Buttery is on Sidgwick Avenue, opposite Newnham College. Freshly baked pastries and sandwiches are available to buy along with a wide selection of hot and cold drinks.

At Sidgwick Site, The Arc Café in the Alison Richard Building also serves lunches and drinks.

Please note that on Saturday both the Sidgwick Site Buttery and the Arc Café are closed, so you will have to use Newnham College Buttery or nearby pubs and restaurants. Here are some suggestions:

Silver Street: The Anchor Pub
